## Agellis receive an order from a South African smelting company for 3 MSEK

**The AGELLIS Group who develop systems and solutions for the global metals industry has received an order for 3,0 MSEK for a measurement instrument from a South African platinum smelting company.**

One of the largest South African Platinum producers has placed an order for an EMLI ELP instrument from Agellis. The ELP instrument measures levels in a platinum smelter which provide input for the smelter operation. Using this information, the production process can be optimized resulting in a higher yield and safer operation.

The majority of the platinum in the world is produced in South Africa and is where the three biggest platinum producers are based. The Agellis focus on non-ferrous metal producers, meaning all metals other than steel, has increased over the last few years. The measurement instrument EMLI ELP has been developed with this market in mind. Agellis has applied for a patent for the ELP measurement principle.
